


A Designer's Insight: Louis Robertson

Louis Robertson, Assistant Product Manager and designer at Vango, takes us through what inspires him in the design and development of tents.

What inspires you at the research and design phase of tent development?

'I usually take inspiration from architecture, cars and their interesting shapes and angles. I always carry a note book to scribble down ideas and designs when I am out and about as well as taking lots of pictures. I try and put myself in the mindset of the camper and identify what people actually need from the tent, even at the early stage of designing the structure of a tent. Experiencing camping myself, in various types of tents, it is really important to ensure I understand how things work and how to make camping even more fun. Before I started working at Vango I would often think of ways to improve my camping experience, from increasing living space and light to the ease of pitching. Over the years Vango has pioneered the way we camp and is always thinking of the next step ahead. I really like having lots of head room and large windows for maximising light in the living area and Vango's patented TBS®||



helps when there is a strong wind (the Tension Band System is used for stability in windy conditions). The best innovation has to be Vango AirBeam®, launched three years ago. The no - pole AirBeam® structure means tents can be pitched in only 3 to 10 minutes depending on the size of tent. This makes it much easier go away on short and spontaneous weekend breaks!

At Vango, we spend a lot of time talking to campers, finding out what works, what doesn't and what problems they face. We take customer feedback and insight very seriously and this helps develop our range, often sparking new innovations in the design of our equipment. We want to ensure that we continue to make the best outdoor gear that is easy to use, comfortable and durable to suit new or seasoned campers alike'.

Take us through your role and the stages involved in developing a tent ready for a new season...

'It is quite a varied and complex process to get a tent collection produced from start to finish. The research and first design phase usually starts in September, eighteen months ahead of launch into stores. The first few months we seek inspiration from everywhere, listening to our customers and the problems faced when camping and developing new ways to improve the way people camp. Using all of these insights, we produce a range of design concepts. We then

review and analyse these numerous times before creating samples. We then start to slowly refine the core collection. Manufacturing is then carried out throughout the winter and shipping commences ready for the spring season in-store. That's when campers can see the new range, ready for the season ahead!'

Quality is paramount in any product. How does Vango control quality?

'Quality starts right at the beginning of the process and is prime from the initial paper sketches right through to after sales. It needs to happen right at the beginning of the process to ensure there is thorough quality control at every stage.

Throughout the design period, we have to work very closely with technical and quality teams at our factories - scrutinising every detail of the technical specification. At Vango, we have a dedicated after sales division (AMG Group Services) that provides excellent customer care, including the repair of our products under warranty. In addition, Camping Spares and Repairs online has been set up for customers to purchase replacement poles, pole sections and spares.

If we didn't have quality control, we wouldn't have a business! It is paramount to everything we do'.
